Dear Parents/ Carers,

I hope you all enjoyed the glorious half-term weather; as I write this, we now seem to have reverted to typical British summer weather though!

It has been wonderful to welcome back more children this week from YR/ Y1 and Y6. However, this would not have been possible without the hard work and good will of all of the staff who have ensured that school is as safe as it can be for your children. I would also like to thank you for trusting us with the care of your children– I know for many of you it has been a difficult decision to make. Please remember that you will not be fined if you choose to keep your child at home. Please note that we do have the capacity for all of our YR, Y1 and Y6 children to return so please contact school if you wish to take up a place.

In order to keep everyone in school safe (children and adults), I need to respectfully remind you of the following:

- If your child or anyone in your household displays symptoms of coronavirus, including loss of taste and/or smell, you must not bring your child to school. It is vital that you inform school immediately, by telephone, so that we can take appropriate action.
- Children should not bring in book bags, books or toys from home.
- Please ensure you continue to follow current government advice: you can meet in groups of up to 6 from different households – but only outside - and you must continue to follow the 2m distancing rule.

For children not currently in school, please continue with your home learning; staff have their PPA time every Friday to make contact with you, if they have not already done so earlier in the week. I would also like to reassure you that when the Government asks us to take other year groups back in to school we will do everything we can to accommodate this in the safest way possible.
