Dear Parents/Carers,

In the light of the news of the new, concerning Covid variant, we are taking extra precautionary measures in school. Face coverings will be worn by adults in communal areas and we are trying to reduce the amount of mixing of classes indoors. We will also be asking any visitors to school to carry out a lateral flow test before they arrive.

At the moment, we are still planning on going ahead with the Christmas performances – however, these may be cancelled at very short notice dependent on Government and Local Authority advice. **If the performance does go ahead, face coverings for adults will be compulsory and we will be requesting that everyone carries out a lateral flow test before attending.** You will also need to wrap up warmly as doors and windows will be open!
