Dear Parents/ Carers,

It is difficult to believe that we are nearly half way through this academic year; time seems to be racing by and there is still so much to look forward to!

It has been a difficult few weeks with the number of Covid cases we have experienced in school (let alone the hay bale fire!). Can we just remind you that if your child has been asked to do a lateral flow test for a certain amount of time, please make sure you remember to test them every morning before school. This is the guidance that we have received. We need to remain vigilant; some restrictions may have been eased but the virus has not gone away. Until half term, staff will still wear face coverings in corridors and at the gate. If anyone is coming to school for an appointment, can we ask that they also wear a face covering whilst in the building please.

### **P.E. kits**

Children should only wear PE kits for school when it is their day for a P.E. lesson. On non-P.E. lesson days, they should be in normal uniform. Thank you.
