### **Value of the term**

Tolerance



Dear Parents/ Carers,

I hope you all had a good Christmas and New Year. It has been wonderful to see all of the children back in school and it is worth reminding ourselves of how different things are to a year ago when schools were being closed again to most pupils.

However, we all still have to be rigorous in ensuring we do everything we can to keep everyone in the school and wider community safe. The Omicron variant is much more infectious and symptoms do resemble a cold, so if your child is feeling unwell for any reason at all, we ask that you please keep them off and get them tested. Government guidance is that if anyone in the house tests positive, the whole household should be taking LFTs every day for 7 days.

There is also updated guidance, below regarding isolation periods. The guidance also applies to children and young people who usually attend an education or childcare setting:

- You may be able to end your self-isolation period before the end of the full 10 days.
- You can take an LFD test from 6 days after your symptoms started, or from the day your test was taken if you do not have symptoms.
- You should do another LFD test the following day, at least 24 hrs after the first one.
- If both these LFD tests are negative and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result.
- You should not take an LFD test before day 6 of your isolation period.
- You should stop testing after 2 consecutive negative LFD tests.
