KS1 and KS2 Assessments

After a two-year absence, end of Key Stage assessments are back on the timetable. Y6 SATS will take place week commencing 9th May – it is important that all Y6 children are in school every day and that they are well rested and ready to show what they know. Y2 assessments will take place over the last two weeks in May – again it is important that all Y2 children are in school over this period. Pupils in Year 1 will undertake the Phonic Screening Check and Year 4 will undertake the new Multiplication Test

Uniform.

Please ensure that your child is in school uniform on non-PE days. Jewellery should be kept to a minimum – a watch and one pair of stud earrings.

Attendance.

Attendance is currently 91% - our levels have been affected by several Covid cases since Christmas. Please remember to let school know by 9.00am if your child will not be attending on that day.
