### **Restore, Recover and Reconnect – Our Curriculum Intent for September 2020.**

Our current curriculum is designed to support teachers to make the decisions that they feel is right for the children they are working with. It recognises the impact of the recent and current pandemic on our learning community.

The key aims of our curriculum are:

1. To ensure that all children have the opportunity to respond to the recent pandemic through positive PSHE that enables them to reflect, discuss and understand the impact upon their community.

5. To ensure that cognitive strategies are revisited, developed and enhanced so children are able to secure knowledge at a deeper level.
6. To secure the skill of being a learner.

By continuing to adopt a Nurturing approach for all children and by showing compassionate care, kindness and candour, we will enable our pupils to continue to develop their emotional resilience and learn how to learn in a school environment once again.
